Additional Addendum: (Please read and Initial were noted)

1: I understand I am making a commitment for myself/my child to participate in The Gardens Sports Academy Summer Show 2024. All show participants must attend and be on time for all rehearsals, mandatory dress rehearsal and shows unless excused in advance by the Show Committee. Anyone who misses more than 1 absence (including sickness) will need to have their role evaluated and potentially could be removed from the show. If more than one absence occurs due to illness, a doctor's note will be required to continue in show. Continued lateness to practice could result in a lesser part (or choreography) for the skater or removal from his/her part(s).

2: Costume Measurements; I understand that all skaters must get measured for their costumes and must come to one of the following dates to get sized for their show costume.

Wednesday, July 10th 6:00 – 7:00pm

Please note: Measurements should take about 3 minutes.

3: Solos, Duets, and Trios are generally given to skaters who maintain continual private lessons and are Freeskate 6 and above.

Please note: Skaters who are considered for a solo, duet and trio, (and parents) agree to:

- pay for additional choreography as needed, pay for custom made costume as needed.
- pay for additional ice time to develop choreography and use freestyle time to rehearse.

4: Show refunds are only considered in the event of injury. Refunds may be requested in writing along with a doctor's note and submitted to the Skating Director.

5: Any complaints, including casting should be submitted in writing to be reviewed by the show committee. No complaints may be directed to the show director or any designated choreographers.

6: Contract Due Date: I understand that in order to be considered for Solos and Duet/Trios all contracts must be submitted by **June 5th**. Contracts submitted after this date may be accepted by the discretion of the Show Director. **An additional fee of \$20 will be assessed for any contracts that are accepted by the Show Director after June 5th.**

_____Friends and Family– assist chairs with collecting forms, payment and ensuring skaters are photographed for the program.

_____Photography (as needed)– assist with Friends and Family pictures or other publicity needs.

_____Backstage crew– assist with props and scenery, before (move to rink from storage unit), during and after the shows.

_____Costume Coordinator—assist in communicating and coordinating with a specific “group”. May involve assisting during rehearsals.

_____Show Program—assist in designing the show program. Includes organizing cast pictures, data input and layout.

_____Gatekeeper– experienced show parents who can be on the ice for one or more shows ensuring skaters are at their proper entrance/exit gates, may involve assisting moving props, scenery, or costume changes.

_____Flowers (as needed)– assist chairs assemble pre-purchased flower bouquets for skaters; this is usually done the Saturday morning of the show and is dependent on number of orders received.

_____Props/Scenery– assist chair with making or obtaining props/scenery pieces; creativity and execution skills required.

_____Clean Up After Last Show– help break down sets, load trucks, pack storage units, etc. I understand that the Show Committee will do their best to accommodate my areas of interest.
