Show Date: August 18, 2023. Time 6:00pm

Application Deadline: June 14th (2 weeks prior to the start of rehearsals)

The Annual Summer Show is a fun, rewarding opportunity for Gardens Sports Academy members and other skaters to demonstrate their skills and interact with their skating community. Skaters have the opportunity to participate in large groups, small groups and/or duet/trio and solo numbers depending on skill level, testing and competition achievements. All Learn to Skate and Academy skaters are encouraged to participate in this event.

Group registration options and fees:

Two group numbers (all levels) = \$50

One Duet/trio and two group numbers (Pre freeskate and Higher) =\$100

Solo, Duet/trio and two Group numbers (FS6 and higher) =\$150

Skaters will be placed in specific numbers by the show director based on the overall ability of the skater. The show director will consider all facets of the skater when determining their placement in the show including current moves in the field, current freestyle level, number of competitions, skaters age, presence or performance ability on the ice, ice etiquette, overall attitude during classes, etc. All elements of a skater's abilities are carefully considered before placing them in various group numbers. Skaters agree to accept any role for which they are cast.

Practice schedule

Practice for group numbers will begin Wednesday June 28th 6:00pm-7:00pm and will be held every week.

Duets/Solos choreography will begin Friday July 1st (**Start at 3:30pm**) and will be held every week.

Dress Rehearsal, **Thursday August 17th at 5:00pm.** (All are required to attend)

Additional Show Costs:

Costumes- A \$25 costume deposit will be required at the time of registration. Generally, costumes will range from \$30-\$75 per number and will be decided by the show committee. The total cost for costumes will be paid upon delivery of the costumes. Once costumes are ordered, they are not returnable or refundable.

1: I understand I am making a commitment for myself/my child to participate in The Gardens Sports Academy Summer Show 2023. All show participants must attend and be on time for all rehearsals, mandatory dress rehearsal and shows unless excused in advance by the Show Committee. Anyone who misses more than 1 absence (including sickness) will need to have their role evaluated and potentially could be removed from the show. If more than one absence occurs due to illness, a doctor's note will be required to continue in show. Continued lateness to practice could result in a lesser part (or choreography) for the skater or removal from his/her part(s).

2: Costume Measurements; I understand that all skaters must get measured for their costumes and must come to one of the following dates to get sized for their show costume.

Wednesday, June 28 5:00 – 6:00pm

Friday, July 1st 2:00 – 3:00pm

Please note: Measurements should take about 3 minutes.

3: Solos, Duets, and Trios are generally given to skaters who maintain continual private lessons and are Freeskate 6 and above.

Please note: Skaters who are considered for a solo, duet and trio, (and parents) agree to:

- pay for additional choreography as needed, pay for custom made costume as needed.
- pay for additional ice time to develop choreography and use freestyle time to rehearse.

4: Show refunds are only considered in the event of injury. Refunds may be requested in writing along with a doctor's note and submitted to the Skating Director.

5: Any complaints, including casting should be submitted in writing to be reviewed by the show committee. No complaints may be directed to the show director or any designated choreographers.

6: Contract Due Date: I understand that in order to be considered for Solos and Duet/Trios all contracts must be submitted by **June 14th**. Contracts submitted after this date may be accepted by the discretion of the Show Director. **An additional fee of \$20 will be assessed for any contracts that are accepted by the Show Director after June 14th.**
